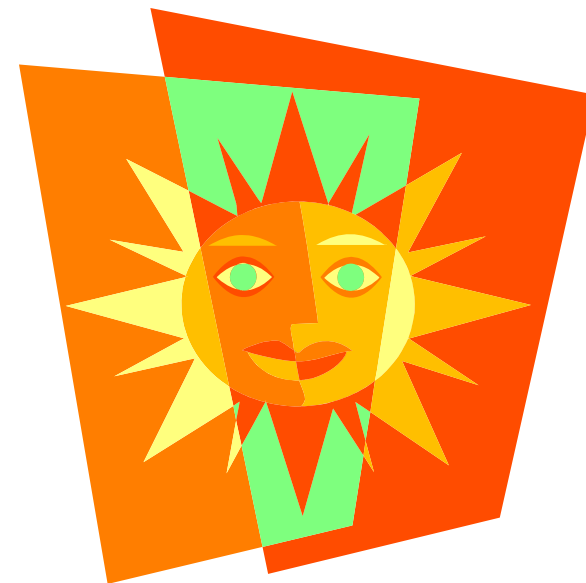
**Fitness Training** Enrollment: Min 10 / Max 10 students
