Submission Guidelines

Your summer reading assignment must be submitted **before** the start of 2010-2011 academic year. Set-up your account at www.turnitin.com by following these directions:

Step 1: Create a profile

Go to www.turnitin.com and click on “**New Users**” in the upper right hand corner of the screen. At that time, you will be prompted to enter the following:

After you enter this information, you will be prompted to create a personal password. Write this password down in a secure place and remember that it is case sensitive and alpha-numeric.
