Adult Education Diploma

The evening Adult Education Program provides classes for adults, out-of-school youth, and in-school youth the opportunity to earn credits toward a 20 credit high school diploma.



College Prep Classes

If you are in need of taking a course in preparation for a college program, we can help. We offer a variety of classes including, Biology (with lab), Chemistry (with lab), Algebra, and several others. Many adult learners who have graduated are successfully enrolled in various programs at surrounding colleges.

Credit Recovery

If a student has failed a class during day school the student is able to recover credit (s) in the evening adult education program. There are a variety of courses available for .5 credit to help students achieve the 24 credit diploma.



GED Program

We offer both the GED and the GED Practice tests at our Testing site. Testing is administered on an individual basis by appointment only.
