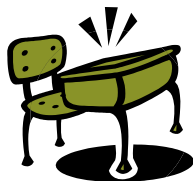
## Worried about SAT Scores?



The SAT is an important step in the college application process. Many parents and students agonize over how to do well on this test. With that in mind, over the years, we've been bombarded with questions from students and parents about how to best prepare for the SAT.

In response to those concerns, we have teamed up to offer a new SAT prep course that will offer testing strategies, ideas, and question examples to prepare students for the 2006-2007 SAT Test dates. SAT Tests are administered on the following dates:

October 14, 2006; November 4, 2006; December 2, 2006; January 27, 2007; March 10, 2007; May 5, 2007; & June 2, 2007.

## WHEN WILL THE COURSE BE OFFERED?

Beginning with Thursday, September 7th and Saturday, September 9th (the week after Labor Day), the course will be offered at LHS on Thursday evenings from 6-9pm OR Saturday mornings from 9am-12pm. On Thursdays, we will meet September 7th, 14th, 21st, 28th, and October 5th. We will also offer a refresher session on Thursday, November 16th from 6-9pm.
