

## **Earning of Credit**

Students can earn course credit by demonstrating mastery of the required coursework and material in accordance with *Policy IKF, High School Graduation*. Mastery is defined in accordance with *Policy ILBAA High School Competency Assessments* as: sufficient evidence of attainment of the required content, concepts, and skills of a particular course. Student assessment of mastery is the responsibility of a certified educator.

Credit will be awarded upon satisfactory demonstration of the district-specified curriculum, assessment standards, and mastery of the required course competencies.
